

Kindergarten - Grade 3



- 1 package of wax crayons (16 or 24 count)
- 1 package of 12 (or more) pencil crayons
- 1 package of 8 (or more) markers (*Crayola or Mr. Sketch are best because they last all year without drying out*)
- Pencils (at least 20 but more is better)
- White erasers (at least 5)
- 5 or 6 large glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 black Sharpies
- 3-6 dry erase markers
- 1 or 2 hard pencil boxes (*This will depend on how many you need to hold the supplies. They need to hold crayons, pencil crayons, markers, scissors, pencil, eraser and a glue stick.*)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 duotangs
- 1 set of headphones in a Ziploc bag (*Please do not send earbuds as they do not last and they are hard on young ears. Please ensure that the headphones are not Bluetooth - they need a cord to plug in.*)
- 1 Pair of indoor shoes. (*Please practice with your child putting on and taking off their shoes. This can often be an overwhelming task for students at the beginning of the year.*)
- 1 reusable water bottle
